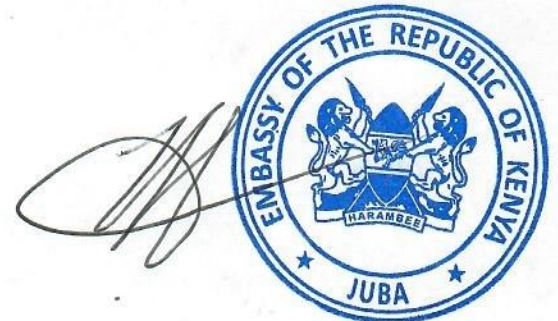
The Embassy of the Republic of Kenya, in Juba, South Sudan intends to undertake a project titled “Fencing of the Kenya Embassy Plot” on plot No. 1 BK AXV, Hai Matar 1st Class in Juba.

The Embassy invites interested and qualified contractors to submit **bids on construction works** for the project. Kindly **collect the tendering documents from the Embassy** during normal working hours 0900hrs – 1530hrs CAT, from Monday to Friday.

The scope of the project will entail construction of a perimeter stone wall, a metal gate and related works as guided by the bill of quantities provided by the Embassy.

The tenderers **MUST** meet the following minimum requirements to be eligible:

1. Submission of a detailed company profile,
2. Submission of audited financial statements for the last (3) years (**2022, 2023 and 2024**) including current profit and loss statements, balance sheet and cash flow information;
3. Submission of valid company registration certificate;
4. Submission of valid company operational permits/ licenses;
5. Submission of company tax registration and compliance certificates;
6. Proof of technical capacity (*Curricula Vitae and relevant professional*



testimonials for technical staff);

7. The Company should provide evidence of similar projects undertaken by the company with relevant references.

NOTE:

1. This tender is only open to those who meet the eligibility criteria.
2. Tendering documents will be issued free of charge.
3. All pages of the tenders must be paged/ serialized as appropriate and stamped;
4. Quoted figures should be in USD and computer typed;
5. Tender documents should be signed by the company's authorized person;
6. Bidders should indicate project completion time in days;
7. The successful bidder will be required to provide the labour, materials, equipment, supervision, and personnel necessary to accomplish the project.

Bidders are notified that:

- i. The applicable procurement law for this tender is the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 of Kenya.
- ii. Representatives of companies who will have submitted their bids may attend the opening of bids on 21st March, 2025 at 1030hrs CAT.
