2. Tenders shall be quoted in **United States Dollars (USD)** and shall include all applicable taxes and Levies.
3. Tenders shall remain valid for **One Hundred and Twenty-Six (126) days** from the date of opening.
4. All tenders shall be accompanied by a Tender Security equivalent to **one and a half percent (1.5%)** of the total tender sum.
5. Prices quoted shall be **fixed** for the entire duration of the contract.
6. A pre-tender site visit will be held on **Monday, 19th January 2026 at 12:00 noon** (Central Africa Time).
7. *Completed, serialized, and paginated bidding documents consisting of one (1) original and one (1) copy shall be enclosed in plain sealed envelopes clearly marked on the top with the Tender Number and Tender Name/Description, and shall be addressed to the:

Tenders will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of the bidders or their duly authorized representatives who choose to attend.
9. Late tenders shall be rejected.
10. The Evaluation and Qualification Procedures shall be as specified in the Tender Document.
11. All other conditions stated in the Invitation to Tenderers shall remain unchanged.
